We are seeking to recruit a number of Relief Project Workers with flexibility to work across our residential or community projects on an 'as and when needed' basis. The role involves assisting the Project Manager/Project Team Leader with running the project, motivating, empowering and supporting Service Users whether in supported accommodation or community based projects. There may be opportunities to work directly with clients across housing and homelessness, employability, and domestic abuse services. This is an excellent opportunity to gain some experience of the organisation delivering a breadth of services to a variety of client groups.

The successful applicant will have experience of working with vulnerable people in a paid or unpaid capacity, an understanding of the benefits systems, safeguarding and domestic violence issues and a knowledge of drug and alcohol misuse. You will have excellent interpersonal, communication, and organisational skills and the ability to build cooperative working relationships. With strong emotional resilience you will be passionate about working with our client group. Qualified to at least NVQ Level 2 in a relevant field is essential.

Hours: working 'as and when needed' but principally daytime hours; however some roles may involve evenings or weekends.

Salary: £9.02 - £10.00 per hour (£17,345 - £19,233 per annum FTE)
